Watching four Top Fuel or Funny Cars stage and then race easily matches Las Vegas sensory overload. But if it's not enough, the track is located 20 miles away from The Strip and downtown Las Vegas. You can go out to the track during the day, and then return to town in the late afternoon to choose from its famous array of food and entertainment experiences. Lodging options are endless, so we chose a couple that are often used by people in the sport. Dining options are almost infinite, with pretty much every type of food available within a five-mile

radius. One unique spot is the Italian American Club, a throwback restaurant with the coolest retro atmosphere around. Places of note include the Neon Museum, which showcases the variety of neon signage that has lit up the Las Vegas skyline. Stop at the Welcome to Las Vegas sign for a great IG photo op. And finally, look to the skies for a great airshow at the Nellis Air Force base, located next to the racetrack.
