

The NHRA season kicks off at the home of the NHRA, the Pomona Fairplex. Located 30 miles east of Santa Monica and 30 miles north of Huntington Beach, this track and its neighborhood are a historical drag racing hub. Because of the dense L.A. traffic, anyone going to the race will most likely want to find a hotel within 5 miles of the track. The two listed here are close by and currently used by race teams. So, who
