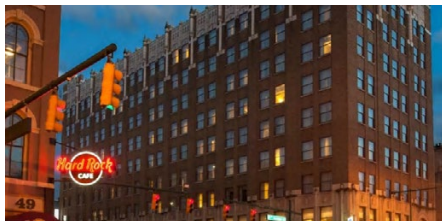


## U.S. NATIONALS . INDIANAPOLIS, IN September 2 - 7, 2020

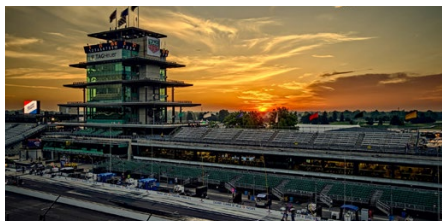
